- 1 Archipelago: A group of islands
- 2 Bay: A large body of water that extends into the land
- 3 Canal: A narrow strip of man-made water used for irrigation, navigation or drainage.
- 4 Coast: The land next to the ocean or sea.
- 5 Delta: A triangular shape land mass formed at the mouth of a river by the sediment
- 6 Island: A small land mass completely surrounded by water
- 7 Lake: A small body of water surrounded by land.
- 8 Ocean: 1 of Earth's 5 largest bodies of water

9 Peninsula: A land mass that juts out into a body of water and is surrounded by water on 3 sides.

10 Plateau: A large elevated piece of land with at least 1 steep side

11 River: A large natural stream that flows into another body of water

12 River Mouth: The point where a river ends and empties into an ocean or sea.

13 River Source: The place where a river begins, usually originating in a stream

14 Strait: A narrow strip of water connecting 2 large bodies of water

15. Tributary: A fresh-water stream that feeds into a larger stream, river or other body of water.
